HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE AMT

Sign Up Today!

Create an EMPLOYERS® Agent Marketing Toolbox account that will allow you to build co-branded materials, instantly download marketing pieces to your computer, track the status of your current order(s) from start to finish, review your previous order(s) and more.

1. Visit amt.employers.com.
2. Click “Create an Account.”



3. Fill in the fields with your appropriate information.
4. You will receive an email containing a confirmation link. Click this link within 24 hours in order to validate your account and log into the AMT. If you have not received your confirmation email, or didn't confirm your account within 24 hours, email marketing@employers.com for additional help.

A Couple Things to Note

Registration is a quick process, but if you run into any trouble double check the below:

1. The AMT is a separate system from **EACCESS**®, thus your **EACCESS** login information will not work for the AMT. If you have previously created an account on **EACCESS** but not on the AMT, you will need to create a new account.
2. You will need to login with the email address that is on file with EMPLOYERS. If you would like to use a different email address for registration please email marketing@employers.com.
3. Your logo and signature files must be high-resolution and in .jpeg or .png form. PDF and Word Document Files will not work. If you need help resizing or reformatting your logo or signature please email marketing@employers.com.
